1. Introduction

This document communicates the major new features and changes in this beta release of CAWS 2.3. It also documents known problems and workarounds.

2. Compatible Products

This release has been tested on the following browsers and operating systems:

- Google Chrome, Internet Explorer 11, Edge and Firefox on:
 - Windows 7 SP1
 - Windows 8.1
 - Windows 10
- Google Chrome, Safari, and Firefox on:
 - OS X Yosemite 10.10.5
 - OS X El Captain 10.11.5
 - OS X Sierra 10.12

3. New Features

The following new features appear in this release:

- Ability to scan customer submitted URLs on multiple OS/Browser combinations:
 - Customers can select “All” option in UI to allow the URL to be scanned in all Operating Systems using all browsers.
- Ability to download Exploit payload via API:
 - Exploit payload can be download using API.
- Ability to download replay metadata via API:
 - Replay metadata can be download via API.

4. Known Limitations and Changed Behavior in this Release

The following limitations exist in this release of CAWS.

- Replay metadata is available only for exploits found after 2.3 release.
- Exploit payload is available only for exploits found after 2.3 release.
- Replay metadata access via API requires “Replay License” enabled in addition to the API License.
- Exploit payload access via API requires “Exploit Payload” license enabled in addition to the API License.
